The Schwenkfelders were the spiritual descendants of the Silesian nobleman Caspar von Schwenkfeld (1489-1562). He was a scholar educated at Cologne, a reformer, and preacher, trying to aid in the cause of the Protestant Reformation. He and his co-believers supported a movement that was popularly known as "The Reformation by the Middle Way". They were relentlessly and bitterly persecuted by the orthodox churches. In 1733 the first members fled to Pennsylvania. Ultimately, 180 Schwenkfelders who were exiled from Silesia emigrated to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, where they landed on 22 Sep 1734. In 1736, another group fled Saxony, including Abraham Beyer, the ancestor of the many American Beyer families.

The migration of the family has been typical of the migration of settlers in America. The first settler of the family Abraham lived near Norristown, PA. His son Andrew moved a little farther west, going to Valley Forge, PA. Andrew's son David moved farther west settling in Sinking Valley, PA.
