Lyman was a trustee of Carroll Twp., Ottawa Co., OH. in 1845 and 1850. He was constable in 1848-49. He served as Justice of the Peace in 1863 and 1871-73. He was the township clerk 1873-74. In 1871 Lyman was elected chairman of the Board of Trustees for the Locust Point United Brethern Church. He was the first Sunday School Superintendent for the church which was built in 1872.

Lyman and Nancy appeared in the 1860 Ottawa Co., OH. census where they lived next to Nancy Lindsley (Meeker) Russell, a sister to Elihu Lindsley, Sr.

Lyman served in Company C of the 33rd Ohio Infantry. He enlisted on 27 Sep 1864 in Sandusky, OH. and was discharged on 05 Jun 1865 in Columbus, OH. He was 5' 10" tall with grey eyes and dark hair.

He farmed most of his life. The family left Ohio, but stopped in Iowa where they appeared in the 1880 Iowa census and probably moved to Kansas about 1882. He bought land in Washington Co., KS. on 13 Sep 1882 while they were listed as living in Iowa Co., IA. He applied for a military disability pension because of problems with his liver and heart as well as piles and rheumatism. He received a pension in 1892. Lyman owned this land until his son Albert Webster Green sold it in 1901 after his death in 1899.

Nancy died ___ 1889 in Washington Co., KS. She was buried in Blocker Cemetery in Washington Co., KS. After Nancy died, Lyman returned to Iowa to live with his daughter Lucinda Yokum where he died on 12 May 1899 in Johnson Co., IA. He was buried in Bethel Cemetery in Washington Twp., Johnson Co., IA. 5. Sherman "Sherm" Green was born 29 Mar 1865 in _____ Co., OH. Family stories tell that he had an eye shot out in a gunfight. Other versions say he was shot while working as a blacksmith on one of the trails in Kansas. Yet another story says he was told by a Mexican farmer that he couldn't cross his land. Sherm wasn't going to let any Mexican tell him what to do. He seems to have boarded with the Morse family and may have worked as a farmhand. The family lived on the southeast corner of Duff-Washa Road and Locust Point Road (now Humphrey Road). Sherm seems to have watched the Morse children grow up, eventually marrying the oldest daughter Almeda "Meed" Morse (born ____ 18__ in _____ Co., __., daughter of John and _____ (_____) Morse) on 7 Nov 1892 in Ottawa Co., OH. He started a livery stable in Marblehead, OH. One old-timer told of putting one of Sherm's wagons on an out-going rail car on Halloween and Sherm had to go get it the next day at a nearby town. He just laughed with the kids. He did become angry when he saw horses being abused. Sherm died ____ 1909 in Ottawa Co., OH. Stories tell that he was punched in the jaw in a bar fight which he seemed to enjoy and developed cancer of the mouth. Almeda married 2.) Edwin Lynch.
