The Sellaire or Cellier family of France were Huguenots. They fled France after the Revocation of the Edict of Nantes by Louis XIV on 18 Oct 1685, settling in the Palatine of Germany. Many of these families eventually fled Germany to England to find religious freedom.

Family tradition holds that Jacques Zeller/Celliere/Sellaire and his wife Clothilde de Valois were French Huguenots who resided for a time in the Palatinate, but moved to England by 1709. They soon migrated to America, arriving in New York on 14 Jun 1710. Since there is no record of Jacques, he must have either died in England or in route on the Atlantic. Johannes (see # 173 for this line) and Jean Henri/ Johann Heinrich seem to have been brothers, but this has not been proven.

Johann Heinrich (Jean Henri) Zeller (Z1) was born ___ ___ 1684 in _____, __. He has been reported to have been born in France, but this does not seem likely. He married Anna Maria Briegal (Z1/W/, born ___ ___ 16__ in _____ Co., __., daughter of James and _____ (_____) Briegal/Van Bruegal) on ___ ___ 17__ in _____ Co., __. They fled Etzbach (near Wissen), Germany to London in 1708. On 14 Jun 1710 they came to New York with the other Palatines. They settled in Livingston Manor in Sullivan Co., NY. in 1710. The family appeared in the New York Subsistence list in June 1710 with two adults and no children. The Sept 1712 Subsistence list included three adults and one child under 10.

Both Johann Heinrich (Hans Henrich) and Johannes were on the volunteer list for the Canadian Expedition of 1711. Both were listed as from Annsberg. In 1713 both men moved to the Schoharie Valley of New York. The immendinger Register includes Hanss Henrich Zoller, his wife and three children.

About 1727 they moved overland to Tulpehocken, Lancaster (now Berks) Co., PA. where he built up an estate. He purchased 115 acres of land from Caspar Wistar, the Philadelphia brass-button maker. This land was located on a branch of the Swatara Creek, northwest of the present village of Stouchberg in present day Berks County. He later bought another 115 acres adjacent to the first tract in a patent of 10 Oct 1750. His house was still standing in 1901. Johann Heinrich seems to be the Henry Zeller listed in the will of Johannes Zeller (probably Henry's brother) on 03 Sep 1737.

On 03 Aug 1754, he had his will drawn. He gave his plantation and all of his moveable estate to his son Johann George Zeller who was to pay to rest of the heirs their share. His two sons Johann Henrich and Johann David were to have 40 pounds, but Johann George was to care for them, "they being simple." He provided for his wife Anna Maria and nominated his son John and son-in-law Leonard Anspach as executors. Johann Henrich died ___ Jan 1756 in Berks Co., PA. His will was probated 20 Jan 1756 (Will Book 1, page 13). Anna Maria died ___ ___ 17__ (1765 ?) in _____ Co., __. Johann Henrich and Anna Maria were buried in _____ Co., __.

On 28 Dec 1772 John Zeller of Berks County, Anna Maria Saltzgeber, widow of Lancaster County, John Pontius of Berks County in right of his wife Anna Catharine,

Leonard Schwartz of Berks County in right of his wife Anna Elizabeth, Barbara Leru (Lerew/Larue) of (blank), and Hartman Zeller of Frederick County, MD. released and quitclaimed their rights in the 245 acres in the estate, implying that their mother had died.

John is said to have served in the civil service as a private in the Revolutionary War.

There is a family tradition that John offered a tract of land for a Lutheran and Reformed Church and Cemetery. However, it was built further east of Martin Dreisbach's land. When the Dreisbach Church was built in 1788, a John Pontius was a Reformed member. John also set aside land for a school and a cemetery on the south side of the Bucher tract.

In the 1790 Northumberland Co., PA. census, John and Catherine were living alone, probably east of Mifflinburg. John made his will on 16 Jun 1792 in Northumberland (now Union) Co., PA. He died ____ 179_ (1792-1794 when the will was probated) in Buffalo Twp., Union Co., PA. He left a legacy to his daughter Mary Welker and her children.

Anna Catherine died ____ 17__ (c 1795) in Buffalo Twp., Union Co., PA. John and Catherine were probably buried in the Pontius Cemetery east of Mifflinberg, Union Co., PA. though their graves are no longer marked.
