## Driving Directions from Hotel

### San Diego Zoo (Hours 9 am- 5pm)

Take Interstate 8 East. Take first turnoff which is 163 South. Follow 163 South to Park Blvd. Exit. At Park Blvd, turn left. Follow Park Blvd to Zoo.

### Sea World (Hours 9 am- 11 pm)

Take Interstate 8 West. Exit at Sports Arena Blvd/ Mission Bay Dr. Turn right at light. Drive over bridge and follow signs to Sea World.

### Harbor Excursion Cruise

Take Interstate 8 West to Interstate 5 South. Take the Front / 2<sup>nd</sup> St exit. Take a right on Broadway to Harbor Dr.

### Seaport Village

Take Interstate 8 West to Interstate 5 South. Exit on Sassafras St. Turn left on Kettner Blvd.

### Tijuana Mexico

Take Interstate 8 West to Interstate 5 South. Follow to the border. Be sure to have your passport. It is best to take the last US exit and park your car on the American side.

**We have done some preliminary work on the cost of installing a monument to honor Johannes & Susanna Sauvage on the site of their land, purchased of 1743 in Berks County, Pennsylvania. Initial estimates were as high as \$4,000 to find and place a stone from the area and mounting a 14 x 18" bronze marker on the stone. We currently have about \$1200.00 in the cemetery fund.**

**In honor of Johannes H & his wife Susanna Sauvage  
 Arrived Philadelphia PA 05 Sep 1738  
 Purchased this tract of 100 acres 20 March 1743  
 Johannes died 1761 - Susanna unknown  
 Johannes & Susanna were probably buried at this site in a cemetery vacated in 1863  
 Erected by the Sauvage/Sowash/Soash Family Association May 2001**
