Johannes & Susanna Sauvage Memorial Update


As you may remember, we were negotiating with the landowner in Berks County, PA. to place a memorial on the land that Johannes bought in 1743. Just as I thought we had all the details worked out and a mason to build the marker, the landowner requested a payment of \$4,500 for a 99 year lease on the property. As the association just barely had sufficient funds for the marker, it was clearly impossible to continue with the project.

After contacting several local people, they suggested that I contact the Fleetwood Gun Club, which owned a part of the original track of land. With the help of Rick Huber and other members of the Gun Club, we had the plaque embedded into a concrete bench. Rick and other members poured the concrete pad for the bench and moved the bench to the site.

Although this was not our first choice for monuments and locations, it is a good alternative. The site is about 125 feet from abandoned cemetery where Johannes & Susanna are probably buried. A special thanks to Rick and the members of the Fleetwood Gun Club for allowing the association to place the memorial on their property and for their help in erecting the bench.

The plaque is engraved:

In Honor Of Johannes H. Sauvage (1698?- 1761) And His Wife Susanna Arrived Philadelphia, Pa. 05 Sep. 1738 Purchased This Land 20 March 1743 Probably Buried At This Site In The Cemetery Vacated In 1863 Erected By The Sauvage / Sowash / Soash Family Association 2001 Original Land Purchase in Berks County. The cross marks the abandoned
